Consider the award or rejection of contracts for highway construction and maintenance, and construction and rehabilitation of buildings (Presentation) *These proposed minute orders contain information concerning the receipt of bids for highway improvement contracts. The department may reschedule receipt of bids for those projects where the commission rejects all bids. Those bids accepted by the commission will result in conditional contract awards to the low bidders. Contract award conditions may involve securing funding from other sources, the contractor's ability to satisfy federal DBE subcontracting requirements, or other requirements as outlined in the project bid proposal.*

Update to the development of the 2024 Unified Transportation Program (UTP) planning targets (Presentation)

The Unified Transportation Program (UTP) is a 10-year statewide plan for transportation project development. The purpose of this presentation is to update the discussion of the 2024 UTP planning targets and investment strategy based on a revised planning cash forecast.

6. Approval of Connection of Sam Houston Tollway to SH 225

Harris County - Consider approval of the request by Harris County to connect the Sam Houston Tollway to non-tolled SH 225 in Harris County by means of five direct connectors to be constructed by Harris County at the interchange of the Sam Houston Tollway and non-tolled SH 225; consider the granting of permission to Harris County to use state highway right-of-way as necessary to construct, operate, and maintain the five direct connectors; consider granting authority to the executive director to take all actions necessary to carry out the purposes of this minute order (Presentation) (MO)

Harris County wishes to construct an interchange consisting of five direct connectors connecting the Sam Houston Tollway to non-tolled SH 225. Pursuant to Title 43, Section 11.58 of the Texas Administrative Code, Harris County has submitted a request to the executive director to approve that connection. Pursuant to Transportation Code Section 228.011(a), the department shall allow certain counties, including Harris County, to use state highway right-of-way and to access the state highway system as necessary to construct and operate a toll project, and Harris County is required to reimburse the department for its actual costs to acquire the right of way. This minute order approves the connection of the Sam Houston Tollway to non-tolled SH 225, and authorizes the use of state highway right-of-way by Harris County to construct, operate, and maintain the five direct connectors at that interchange, and authorizes the department to waive the County's required reimbursement if the value of any right-of-way transferred to the department by the County for the five direct connectors exceeds the amount of the required reimbursement.

7. Aviation

Various Counties - Consider the award of federal non-primary entitlement grant funding and federal apportionment grant funding for airport improvement projects at various locations (MO) *Federal law authorizes the award of federal non-primary entitlement grant funding and federal apportionment grant funding to preserve and improve the state's general aviation system.*

8. Advisory Committee Appointment

Consider the appointment of members to the Port Authority Advisory Committee (MO) This minute order approves appointment of members to the Port Authority Advisory Committee to fill expiring and vacated terms. The purpose of the committee, created by state law, is to offer advice and recommendations that will provide the commission and the department with a broad perspective regarding maritime ports and transportation-related matters to be considered in formulating department policies concerning the Texas maritime port system.

9. Texas Private Activity Bond Surface Transportation Corporation

Appoint directors to the Texas Private Activity Bond Surface Transportation Corporation (MO) *The commission authorized the creation of the corporation and appointed three directors to the corporation's board in October 2008. After that initial appointment, vacancies on the board have required subsequent appointments. This minute order appoints a director to replace a director who is currently serving on the board for a six-year term ending August 31, 2023. This minute order also re-appoints all three directors upon the expiration of their terms ending August 31, 2023, each for a six-year term running from September 1, 2023, through August 31, 2029.*

10. Grand Parkway Transportation Corporation

Appoint a director to the Grand Parkway Transportation Corporation (MO) The commission authorized the creation of the corporation and appointed three directors to the corporation's board in March 2012. After that initial appointment, vacancies on the board have required subsequent appointments. This minute order appoints a director to replace a director that is currently serving on the board for a six-year term ending August 31, 2027.

11. **Eminent Domain Proceedings**

Various Counties - Consider the authorization of the filing of condemnation proceedings to acquire real property by eminent domain for non-controlled and controlled access highways (see attached itemized list) (MO)

Commission findings, determinations, and authorizations for the state, by motion made in accordance with Senate Bill 18, 82nd Legislature, to acquire by eminent domain, upon the payment of adequate and just compensation, various ownership interests in specific parcels of real property that are needed to develop or improve both non-controlled and controlled access state highways, to include requesting the state attorney general to bring and pursue condemnation suits relating to those specific parcels of real property described in the attached itemized list.

12. Routine Minute Orders and Reports

a.

Donations to the Department

Various Districts - Consider the acknowledgment of donations with a value of \$500 or more, including donations of money, materials, services, or real property, that are made to the department for the purpose of assisting the department in carrying out its functions and duties or for improving access to or from a highway on the state highway system (see attached itemized list) (MO)

State statutes require the commission to acknowledge the acceptance of a gift to the department that is valued at \$500 or more. By the adoption of this minute order, the commission acknowledges the receipt and acceptance of the property specified in the minute order.

b. Real Estate Dispositions

The commission must approve the sales, transfers, and exchanges of state rights of way and other real properties that are no longer needed for a state highway purpose. It must also approve, accept, and acknowledge donations to the state of real property that is valued at \$500 or more.

(1) Andrews County - FM 1788 - Consider the quitclaim of right of way no longer needed for a highway purpose to the county that acquired the property in its own name for use by the state (MO) The district has determined that the land is no longer needed for highway purposes

(2) **Dallas County** - US 67 - Consider the exchange of drainage channel easements as part of a transaction to acquire a drainage channel easement needed for a state highway purpose (MO)

The district has determined that the easements to be released by the State in the exchange are no longer needed for a state highway purpose. The commission may recommend, subject to approval by the attorney general, that the governor execute an instrument exchanging an interest in real property acquired but not needed for a highway purpose as whole or partial consideration for another interest in real property needed for a state highway purpose.

(3) **Ector County** - FM 2227 - Consider the sale of right of way to an abutting landowner (MO) The district has determined that the land is no longer needed for highway purposes. An abutting landowner has requested to purchase the land, and it may be sold to the requester.

 The district has determined that the land is no longer needed for highway purposes. There is no record title to the property, and the City of Troup has requested the quitclaim of the tract to the abutters. (6) Tarrant County Trinity Boulevard near FM 157 Consider the sale
- (6) Tarrant County Trinity Boulevard near FM 157 Consider the sale of right of way to an abutting landowner (MO)
 The district has determined that the land is no longer needed for highway purposes. An abutting landowner has requested to purchase the land, and it may be sold to the requester.
- (7) Travis County SH 130 Consider the sale of right of way to the City of Pflugerville, Texas (MO) This minute order provides the commission's determinations required for the sale of any Central Texas Turnpike System (CTTS) real or personal property with a value in excess of \$1 million, under Section 713 of the Indenture of Trust securing the commission's CTTS toll revenue bonds. The City of Pflugerville, Texas (city) has requested to purchase the real property, and it may be sold to the city.
- (8) Travis County SH 130 Consider the designation of one location on the SH 130 southbound exit ramp to Parmer Lane at which access will be permitted to the abutting property (MO)

The designation of one 41-foot break in the control-of-access line will allow the abutting landowner to open one driveway for emergency ingress and egress to and from the SH 130 southbound exit ramp to Parmer Lane. The district has determined that access may be permitted at the designated location. This minute order provides the commission's determinations required for the sale of any Central Texas Turnpike System (CTTS) real or personal property with a value in excess of \$1 million, under Section 713 of the Indenture of Trust securing the commission's CTTS toll revenue bonds.

(9) Williamson County - SH 130 - Consider an easement release to the underlying fee owner (MO) The district has determined that the easement is no longer needed for highway is

The district has determined that the easement is no longer needed for highway purposes. The easement may be released to the underlying fee owner.

c. Reports

(1) Compliance Division Report

State law requires the commission to establish a compliance program, which must include a Compliance Division to oversee the program. The Compliance Division is responsible for acting to prevent and detect serious breaches of department policy, fraud, waste, and abuse of office, including any acts of criminal conduct within the department. The Compliance Division is required to provide a monthly report to the commission regarding investigations and a summary of information relating to trends and recommendations.

(2) Quarterly Investment Report

Quarterly Investment Report for all of the funds invested at the direction of the commission (Report)

This is a presentation of the quarterly investment report for the investment of: (1) funds held by the Bank of New York Mellon, as trustee, under the Indenture of Trust securing the Central Texas Turnpike System toll revenue obligations; (2) funds for the pre-paid TxTag account held by the Bank of New York Mellon, acting as custodian; (3) funds held by Amegy Bank, a Division of ZB, National Association, as trustee, under the Trust Agreement securing the I-35E Managed Lanes Project toll revenue obligations; and (4) funds held by U.S. Bank National Association, as trustee, under the Master Trust Agreement securing the SH 249 System toll revenue obligations.

(3) Grimes and Montgomery Counties - Quarterly Traffic and Revenue Report for the State Highway 249 System (Report) The commission financed a portion of the costs of the system with obligations issued pursuant to a trust agreement. In accordance with Section 709 of the trust agreement, the commission is providing to the trustee, general engineering consultant, and traffic consultant a report of general information regarding the system for the preceding fiscal quarter. A copy of the report is being filed with the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board through its Electronic Municipal Markets Access System.

- (4) Travis and Williamson Counties Voluntary Quarterly Report of Actual Traffic and Toll Revenue for the Central Texas Turnpike System (Report) The commission financed a portion of the costs of the system with obligations issued pursuant to a trust indenture. In accordance with Section 501(c) of the trust indenture, the commission covenants that for the first five full years of operation of the system, the commission will provide to the trustee a report showing the traffic and revenue of the system for the previous quarter. The commission may discontinue the reports because the revenues for the previous two years have been sufficient to meet the rate covenant; however, the commission has not exercised its option to discontinue the reports. A copy of the report is being filed with the trustee and the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board through its Electronic Municipal Markets Access System.
- (5) **Grand Parkway Transportation Corporation** Annual report on the status of projects and activities undertaken by the Grand Parkway Transportation Corporation (Report)

The commission's rules (43 Texas Administrative Code §15.90) require transportation corporations to submit a report on the status of projects and appear annually before the commission to discuss the report at the commission's discretion. To satisfy this requirement, the Grand Parkway Transportation Corporation has submitted the annual report to the commission and is appearing to discuss at the commission's discretion.

d. Economically Disadvantaged Counties Program

Various Counties - Consider the approval of the Fiscal Year 2022 Annual Report on the Economically Disadvantaged Counties Program (MO) State law requires the commission to provide an annual report on the Economically Disadvantaged Counties Program to the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the House of Representatives. This report documents the use of matching funds and local incentives as well as the savings to counties participating in the programs.

e. Speed Zones

Various Counties - Consider the establishment or alteration of regulatory and construction speed zones on various sections of highways in the state (MO) *This minute order establishes or alters regulatory and construction speed zones on various sections of highways in the state.*

 Section 551.071 - Consultation with and advice from legal counsel regarding any item on this agenda, pending or contemplated litigation, or other legal matters.
