These proposed minute orders contain information concerning the receipt of bids for highway improvement contracts. The department may reschedule receipt of bids for those projects where the commission rejects all bids. Those bids accepted by the commission will result in conditional contract awards to the low bidders. Contract award conditions may involve securing funding from other sources, the contractor's ability to satisfy federal DBE subcontracting requirements, or other requirements as outlined in the project bid proposal.

Energy Sector Update (Presentation)
Staff will provide an update on the work and needs in the energy sector regions in the state.
7. **Aviation**
Various Counties - Consider the award of federal non-primary entitlement grant funding, federal apportionment grant funding and state grant funding for airport improvement projects at various locations (MO)
Federal law authorizes the award of federal non-primary entitlement grant funding and federal apportionment grant funding to preserve and improve the state's general aviation system. State law authorizes the award of state grant funding for capital improvement projects.
8. **State Infrastructure Bank (Presentation)**
Ellis County - Sardis Lone Elm Water Supply Corporation - Consider final approval of a request from Sardis Lone Elm Water Supply Corporation for a State Infrastructure Bank loan in the amount of up to \$10,793,000 to pay for the costs of two utility relocations necessary for non-tolled on-system projects to widen farm to market 664 in Ellis County, Texas (MO)
Sardis Lone Elm Water Supply Corporation (WSC) will secure the loan with a pledge of contract and water revenues. The loan will be used to pay the WSC's costs associated with two utility relocations necessary for non-tolled on-system projects to widen farm to market 664 in Ellis County, Texas.
9. **Highway Designations**
Cameron County - Between the city of Brownsville and South Padre Island, consider designating SH 104 on a new location on the state highway system (MO)
This minute order designates SH 104 on a new location on the state highway system from FM 106 eastward to Park Road 100 on South Padre Island, a distance of approximately 11.1 miles.
10. **Eminent Domain Proceedings**
Various Counties - Consider the authorization of the filing of condemnation proceedings to acquire real property by eminent domain for non-controlled and controlled access highways (see attached itemized list) (MO)
Commission findings, determinations, and authorizations for the state, by motion made in accordance with Senate Bill 18 (82nd Legislature), to acquire by eminent domain, upon the payment of adequate and just compensation, various ownership interests in specific parcels of real property that are needed to develop or improve both non-controlled and controlled access state highways, to include requesting the state attorney general to bring and pursue condemnation suits relating to those specific parcels of real property described in the attached itemized list.
11. **Routine Minute Orders and Reports**
 - a. **Donations to the Department**
Various Districts - Consider the acknowledgment of donations with a value of \$500 or more, including donations of money, materials, services, or real property, that are made to the department for the purpose of assisting the department in carrying out its functions and duties or for improving access to or from a highway on the state highway system (see attached itemized list) (MO)
State statutes require the commission to acknowledge the acceptance of a gift to the department that is valued at \$500 or more. By the adoption of this minute order, the commission acknowledges the receipt and acceptance of the property specified in the minute order.

b. **Real Estate Dispositions**

The commission must approve the sales, transfers, and exchanges of state rights of way and other real properties that are no longer needed for a state highway purpose. It must also approve, accept, and acknowledge donations to the state of real property that is valued at \$500 or more.

- (1) **Grimes County** - SL 429 - Consider the quitclaim of right of way no longer needed for a highway purpose to the county where the property is located (MO)
The district has determined that the land is no longer needed for highway purposes.
- (2) **Llano County** - RM 2147 - Consider the release of an easement to the underlying fee owner (MO)
The district has determined that the easement is no longer needed for highway purposes. The underlying fee owner has requested to purchase the easement, and it may be sold to the requester.
- (3) **Nueces County** - FM 624 - Consider the release of an easement to the underlying fee owner (MO)
The district has determined that the easement is no longer needed for highway purposes. The underlying fee owner has requested to purchase the easement, and it may be sold to the requester.

c. **Reports**

(1) **Compliance Division Report**

State law requires the commission to establish a compliance program, which must include a Compliance Division to oversee the program. The Compliance Division is responsible for acting to prevent and detect serious breaches of department policy, fraud, waste, and abuse of office, including any acts of criminal conduct within the department. The Compliance Division is required to provide a monthly report to the commission regarding investigations and a summary of information relating to trends and recommendations.

(3) **Environmental Impact Statement Positive, Negative, or Neutral Public Comments Report**

Per Transportation Code §201.811(b) and 43 TAC §2.107(f)(2), this report lists the number of positive, negative, and neutral public comments received from the public hearing held in connection with release of the draft environmental impact statement for the referenced project.

(6) **Environmental Report**

Consider the acceptance of the report on projects being processed under the procedures of Transportation Code, Chapter 201, Subchapter I-1 (Report)

The report identifies projects with a local government sponsor being processed under the environmental review procedures set forth in Transportation Code, Chapter 201, Subchapter I-1. A report must be submitted twice a year to the Texas Transportation Commission, as required by Transportation Code, §201.762(a).

(7) **Grimes and Montgomery Counties - Quarterly Traffic and Operating Report for the State Highway 249 System (Report)**

The Texas Transportation Commission (commission) financed a portion of the costs of the State Highway 249 System (system) with obligations issued pursuant to a trust agreement. In accordance with Section 709 of the trust agreement, the commission is providing to the trustee, general engineering consultant, and traffic consultant a report of general information regarding the system for the preceding fiscal quarter. A copy of the report is being filed with the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board through its Electronic Municipal Markets Access System.

(8) **Travis and Williamson Counties - Voluntary Quarterly Report of Actual Traffic and Toll Revenue for the Central Texas Turnpike System (Report)**

The Texas Transportation Commission (commission) financed a portion of the costs of the Central Texas Turnpike System (system) with obligations issued pursuant to a trust indenture. In accordance with Section 501(c) of the trust indenture, the commission covenants that for the first five full years of operation of the system, the commission will provide to the trustee a report showing the traffic and revenue of the system for the previous quarter. The commission may discontinue the reports because the revenues for the previous two years have been sufficient to meet the rate covenant; however, the commission has not exercised its option to discontinue the reports. A copy of the report is being filed with the trustee and the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board through its Electronic Municipal Markets Access System.

d. **Purchase Order Amendment**

Consider the approval of a material change to a purchase order awarded under Chapter 2155 of the Texas Government Code for the services to deploy a multi-modal demand and mobility management platform (MO)

This minute order proposes an amendment to a purchase order awarded under Government Code, Chapter 2155 for the development and deployment of a smartphone application entitled Houston ConnectSmart, which will integrate multi-modal demand and mobility management with transportation systems and active demand management in the Houston district. Section 2155.088, Government Code, requires that the governing body of a state agency, at a meeting, consider a material change to the contract for goods or services awarded under Chapter 2155, Government Code, and consider why that change is necessary. The proposed amendment is a material change as defined under Chapter 2155.

e. **Speed Zones**

Various Counties - Consider the establishment or alteration of regulatory and construction speed zones on various sections of highways in the state (MO)

This minute order establishes or alters regulatory and construction speed zones on various sections of highways in the state.

12. **Executive Session** Pursuant to Government Code, Chapter 551
Section 551.071 - Consultation with and advice from legal counsel regarding any item on this agenda, pending or contemplated litigation, or other legal matters.
